Goals: Long-Term Objectives

Form Faithful and Effective Christian Leaders

Equip a wide variety of people for a wide variety of gospel informed ministries and missions.

Provide Theological Leadership for the Church and the World

Serve as a premier theological resource for global Christianity through scholarship, convening and advanced theological education.

Create and Embody a Community of Belonging

Build a thriving inclusive Christian community that actualizes the benefits of diversity and unity and transforms its members and, subsequently, the larger world.

Themes: Emphases in the next 3-5 years

Ensure that our Degree Programs are Relevant and Compelling

Develop a slate of distinctive degree programs that draw from sustainable pools of prospective students, broaden access, and produce graduates who can lead flourishing communities.

Create Consequential and Innovative Non-Degree Programs

Design and launch a new set of programs and credentials that extend theological education to new constituencies, equip people for faithful reflection and practice, and generate revenue.

Serve as a Vital and Engaging Hub for Christian Theology & Leadership

Inform and influence discourse in the church and the public square with respect to the most crucial questions and issues of our time.

Establish Covenant Community as a Community of Belonging

Provide transformative experiences in Christian community that brings people together across lines of difference and embodies the reign of God in the world.

Ensure the Financial Sustainability of the Seminary and our Students

Steward the resources of the school and ensure that our students graduate without a life limiting level of debt.
